STEM Opportunity - UCSB School of Scientific Thought (SST)

SST encourages high school students to be curious, learn about cutting-edge research, be inspired by their future opportunities, and engage with positive role-models in the field.

The SST enrichment program is **free** for high school students and offers small science and technology, research-based classes, at the University of California Santa Barbara. **Each class runs for 2 Saturdays - January 22 & 29, 2022- from 10:00-3:00 pm.** Lunch is included for all enrolled students. These classes are scheduled for an in-person experience but may change as required by university guidance.
